

Homegrown for Hopewell Outcomes

- 40 completed the Bootcamp. Stats 109 original applications
- 29 applied to compete in Preliminary Pitch and 26 competed
- 12 competed in Final Pitch in front of judges
- 3 brick and mortar businesses opened

- Over \$250,000 invested in rehabs/buildouts, inventory, supplies, rent etc in addition to a \$200,000 property acquisition
- Impact of over \$450,000.





Resurgence Grant Outcomes

In total, we engaged 236 participants in our Small Scale Development series and offered 39 scholarships to local or BIPOC/SWAM participants

- Recruitment Lecture–147
- Small Developer Seminar 55 *with 13 being scholarships
- Boot Camp –15 *with 7 being scholarships
- Virtual Mini Workshop –19 *all scholarships


